Public Holidays Amendment Act 2019[†]

No. 29 of 2019

[Assented to 10 September 2019]

The Parliament of Victoria enacts:

1 Purpose

The purpose of this Act is to amend the **Public Holidays Act 1993** to make provision for certain public holidays in Victoria.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3 Public holidays

- (1) After section 6(f) of the **Public Holidays Act 1993 insert—**

"(fa) Easter Sunday;"

- (2) After section 6(i) of the **Public Holidays Act 1993 insert—**

"(ia) the Friday before the Australian Football League Grand Final;"

- (3) For section 6(k) of the **Public Holidays Act 1993 substitute—**

"(k) 25 December (Christmas Day);

(ka) the Monday after Christmas Day when Christmas Day is a Saturday or the Tuesday after Christmas Day when Christmas Day is a Sunday;"

4 Repeal of amending Act

This Act is **repealed** on the first anniversary of its commencement.

Note

The repeal of this Act does not affect the continuing operation of the amendments made by it (see section 15(1) of the **Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984**).
