1. *Objective*

The objective of these Regulations is to make further provision for the membership of the Victorian Health Promotion Foundation.

2. *Authorising provision*

These Regulations are made under section 43 of the **Tobacco Act 1987**.

3. *Appointment of members to Victorian Health Promotion Foundation*

(1) In regulation 4 of the Tobacco (Victorian Health Promotion Foundation) Regulations 2000¹, for sub-regulations (9) and (10) **substitute**—
