Magistrates' Court Act 1989

**Magistrates' Court (Judicial Registrars)
Amendment Rules 2009**

The Chief Magistrate together with 2 Deputy Chief Magistrates jointly make the following Rules:

1 Object

The object of these Rules is to amend the Magistrates' Court (Judicial Registrars) Rules 2005 to delegate further powers of the Court to the judicial registrars.

2 Authorising provisions

These Rules are made under sections 16 and 16I of the **Magistrates' Court Act 1989**.

3 Commencement

These Rules come into operation on 20 April 2009.

4 Amendment of Rule 4

After Rule 4(2) of the Magistrates' Court (Judicial Registrars) Rules 2005¹ **insert—**

"(3) A judicial registrar may exercise all or any powers of the Court under section 128A of the **Magistrates' Court Act 1989** in a criminal proceeding for a summary offence or an indictable offence triable summarily."
