**Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities
(Public Authorities) Regulations 2009**

1 Objective

The objective of these Regulations is to declare certain entities not to be public authorities for the purposes of the Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities.

2 Authorising provision

These Regulations are made under section 46 of the **Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities Act 2006**.

3 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 28 December 2009.

4 Revocation

The Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities (Public Authorities) Interim Regulations 2008¹ are **revoked**.

5 Public authorities

Each of the following entities is declared not to be a public authority for the purposes of the **Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities Act 2006**—

- (a) the Adult Parole Board established by section 61 of the **Corrections Act 1986**;
- (b) the Youth Residential Board continued in existence by section 431 of the **Children, Youth and Families Act 2005**;
- (c) the Youth Parole Board continued in existence by section 442 of the **Children, Youth and Families Act 2005**.

6 Expiry

These Regulations expire on 27 December 2013.
