Children, Youth and Families Amendment Regulations 2018

The Governor in Council makes the following Regulations:

1 Objectives

The objectives of these Regulations are to amend the Children, Youth and Families Regulations 2017 to prescribe—

- (a) an employee of Family Safety Victoria as an information holder for the purposes of the **Children, Youth and Families Act 2005**; and
- (b) Family Safety Victoria as a service agency for the purposes of that Act.

2 Authorising provision

These Regulations are made under section 600 of the **Children, Youth and Families Act 2005**.

3 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 26 February 2018.

4 Prescribed information holder

In regulation 6 of the Children, Youth and Families Regulations 2017¹—

(a) in paragraph (g), for "Commonwealth." **substitute** "Commonwealth;";

(b) after paragraph (g) **insert**—

"(h) an employee of Family Safety Victoria, an Administrative Office established by Order in Council under section 11 of the **Public Administration Act 2004** dated 20 June 2017 and published in the Government Gazette on 22 June 2017.".

5 Prescribed service agencies

In regulation 7 of the Children, Youth and Families Regulations 2017—

(a) in paragraph (f), for "Commonwealth." **substitute** "Commonwealth; and";

(b) after paragraph (f) **insert**—

"(g) Family Safety Victoria, an Administrative Office established by Order in Council under section 11 of the **Public Administration Act 2004** dated 20 June 2017 and published in the Government Gazette on 22 June 2017.".
