The Parliament of Victoria enacts:

1 Purpose

The purpose of this Act is to repeal section 19A of the **Crimes Act 1958**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3 Section 19A repealed

Section 19A of the **Crimes Act 1958** is **repealed**.

4 Consequential amendments to Sentencing Act 1991

- (1) Clause 2(c)(iii) of Schedule 1 to the **Sentencing Act 1991** is **repealed**.
- (2) After clause 2(d) of Schedule 1 to the **Sentencing Act 1991** insert—
 - "(da) an offence against section 19A (intentionally causing a very serious disease) of the **Crimes Act 1958** repealed by section 3 of the **Crimes Amendment (Repeal of Section 19A) Act 2015**;"
- (3) Clause 3(b)(ii) of Schedule 1 to the **Sentencing Act 1991** is **repealed**.
- (4) After clause 3(c) of Schedule 1 to the **Sentencing Act 1991** insert—
 - "(ca) an offence against section 19A (intentionally causing a very serious disease) of the **Crimes Act 1958** repealed by section 3 of the **Crimes Amendment (Repeal of Section 19A) Act 2015**;"
- (5) In clause 3(d) of Schedule 1 to the **Sentencing Act 1991**, for "(c)" substitute "(ca)".

5 Repeal of amending Act

This Act is **repealed** on the first anniversary of its commencement.

Note

The repeal of this Act does not affect the continuing operation of the amendments made by it (see section 15(1) of the **Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984**).
