## LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

#### **PROHIBITION OF HUMAN CLONING FOR REPRODUCTION BILL 2008**

#### (Amendments and New Clauses to be moved by Mr Clark )

1. Clause 3, lines 19 to 32, omit all words and expressions on these lines and insert—

"*human embryo* means a discrete entity that has arisen from the creation of a single cell containing 2 pro-nuclei following the fertilisation of a human oocyte by a human sperm;".

- 2. Clause 3, page 3, lines 18 to 20, omit all words and expressions on these lines.
- 3. Clause 3, page 4, lines 12 to 19, omit subclauses (5), (6) and (7).
- 4. Part heading preceding clause 5, omit this heading and insert—

## "Part 2—Prohibited Practices".

- 5. Clause 7, lines 24 and 25, omit "or 6" and insert ", 6 or 7".
- 6. Clause 8, lines 30 to 32, omit "by a process of the fertilisation of a human egg by a human sperm".
- 7. Clause heading to clause 9, omit "by fertilisation".
- 8. Clause 9, lines 14 to 20, omit subclause (1) and insert—
  - "() A person commits an offence if the person intentionally creates or develops a human embryo containing genetic material provided by more than 2 persons.".
- 9. Clause heading to clause 13, after "chimeric" insert "or hybrid".
- 10. Clause 13, after line 28 insert—
  - "() A person commits an offence if the person intentionally creates a hybrid embryo.".
- 11. Clause 13, line 29, after "(1)" insert "or (2)".
- 12. Clause 14, omit this clause.
- 13. Part heading preceding clause 18, omit this heading.
- 14. Clause 18, omit this clause.
- 15. Clause 19, omit this clause.
- 16. Clause 20, omit this clause.

17. Clause 21, omit this clause.

## **NEW CLAUSES**

18. Insert the following new clause before clause 5—

#### "A Offence—creating a human embryo clone

- (1) A person commits an offence if the person intentionally creates a human embryo clone.
- (2) An offence against subsection (1) is an indictable offence punishable by imprisonment for a term not exceeding 15 years.".
- 19. Insert the following new clause after clause 7—

## "B Offence—creating a human embryo other than by fertilisation, or developing such an embryo

- (1) A person commits an offence if the person intentionally creates a human embryo by a process other than the fertilisation of a human egg by human sperm, or intentionally develops a human embryo so created.
- (2) An offence against sub-section (1) is an indictable offence punishable by imprisonment for a term not exceeding 10 years.".
- 20. Insert the following new clause after clause 10—

# "C Offence—using precursor cells from a human embryo or a human foetus to create a human embryo, or developing such an embryo

- (1) A person commits an offence if the person uses precursor cells taken from a human embryo or a human foetus, intending to create a human embryo, or intentionally develops an embryo so created.
- (2) An offence against sub-section (1) is an indictable offence punishable by imprisonment for a term not exceeding 10 years.".
