JUSTICE LEGISLATION FURTHER AMENDMENT (MISCELLANEOUS) BILL
2025(Amendments and New Clauses to be proposed in Committee by SARAH MANSFIELD)

1. Clause 1, page 3, line 15, omit "Court." and insert "Court;".
2. Clause 1, page 3, after line 15 insert—
 - "(hb) to amend the **Independent Broad-based Anti-corruption Commission Act 2011**—
 - (i) to expand the jurisdiction of the Independent Broad-based Anti-corruption Commission; and
 - (iii) to make other related amendments."

NEW CLAUSES

3. Insert the following New Part to follow Part 8—

**'Part 8AAA—Amendment of Independent Broad-based
Anti-corruption Commission Act 2011**

76AAA Definitions

In section 3(1) of the **Independent Broad-based Anti-corruption Commission Act 2011**, the definition of *relevant offence* is repealed.

76AAB Corrupt conduct

After section 4(1)(a) of the **Independent Broad-based Anti-corruption Commission Act 2011** insert—

"(ab) of any person that impairs, or that could impair, public confidence in public administration; or

Examples

Examples of conduct that could impair public confidence in public administration include—

- (a) collusive tendering;
- (b) fraud in relation to the grant by the State of any interest, benefit, licence or permission;
- (c) dishonestly obtaining or assisting in obtaining, or dishonestly benefiting from, the payment or application of public funds for private advantage or the disposition of public assets for private advantage;

- (d) evading a State tax, levy or duty or otherwise fraudulently causing a loss of State revenue;
- (e) fraudulently obtaining or retaining employment or appointment as a public officer."

76AAC Offence to disclose certain information received from the IBAC

After section 184(5)(h) of the **Independent Broad-based Anti-corruption Commission Act 2011** insert—

"(ha) disclosure with the written authorisation of the IBAC;"'.

4. Long title, after "Magistrates' Court," insert "the **Independent Broad-based Anti-corruption Commission Act 2011** in relation to the jurisdiction of the Independent Broad-based Anti-corruption Commission."
