**INDEPENDENT BROAD-BASED ANTI-CORRUPTION COMMISSION
AMENDMENT (ENDING POLITICAL CORRUPTION) BILL 2024**

(Amendments and New Clause to be proposed in Committee by KATHERINE COPSEY)

1. Clause 1, page 2 before line 1 insert—
 - "(bc) to amend that Act in relation to disclosure of information; and".
2. Clause 4, after line 11 insert—
 - '(aa) after paragraph (a) **insert**—
 - "(ab) of any person that impairs, or that could impair, public confidence in public administration; or

Examples

Examples of conduct that could impair public confidence in public administration include—

 - (a) collusive tendering;
 - (b) fraud in relation to the grant by the State of any interest, benefit, licence or permission;
 - (c) dishonestly obtaining or assisting in obtaining, or dishonestly benefiting from, the payment or application of public funds for private advantage or the disposition of public assets for private advantage;
 - (d) evading a State tax, levy or duty or otherwise fraudulently causing a loss of State revenue;
 - (e) fraudulently obtaining or retaining employment or appointment as a public officer.";
 - (aab) in paragraph (e), after "(a)," insert "(ab),".'.

NEW CLAUSE

3. Insert the following New Clause before clause 7—
 - '6C Offence to disclose certain information received from the IBAC**
 - After section 184(5)(h) of the **Independent Broad-based Anti-corruption Commission Act 2011** insert—
 - "(ha) disclosure with the written authorisation of the IBAC;".'.
