'A. Ministerial directions as to requirements for gaming machines

After section 3.2.3(6) of the Principal Act insert—

"(7) Despite anything to the contrary in this section, on or after 15 April 2012 the maximum permissible number of gaming machines available for gaming in the State, including the Melbourne Casino, is 10 000.

See section 62A(2) of the **Casino Control Act 1991** in relation to the maximum permissible number of gaming machines available for gaming at the Melbourne Casino.

- (8) The Minister must ensure that directions given under this section comply with subsection (7) on and from 15 April 2012.
- (9) In this section *Melbourne Casino* has the same meaning as in the Agreement within the meaning of the Casino (Management Agreement) Act 1993.".'.
