FAIR TRADING AMENDMENT (AUSTRALIAN CONSUMER LAW) BILL 2010

(Amendments to be proposed in Committee by Mr BARBER)

- 1. Clause 20, page 20, line 32, omit "the Director" and insert "a majority of the members for the time being of the Advisory Committee established under section 102F".
- 2. Clause 20, page 22, after line 10 insert—

"102F Advisory Committee

- (1) There is to be established an Advisory Committee consisting of not more than—
 - (a) 2 persons appointed by the Minister with an interest in the provision of education, advice or assistance to consumers;
 - (b) 2 persons appointed by the Minister from names submitted by a prescribed body representing interests of suppliers;
 - (c) 2 persons appointed by the Minister from names submitted by a prescribed body representing interests of consumers.
- (2) A member appointed under subsection (1) holds office-
 - (a) for a period not exceeding 3 years, as the Minister determines; and
 - (b) on the terms and conditions prescribed by the regulations.
- (3) A member of the Committee must not participate in a recommendation for payment of an amount from the Fund under section 102D(1) to a body of which that person is an officer, employee or member.
- (4) The application of money from the Fund after a recommendation in which a member has participated in contravention of subsection (3) is not invalid.".
