TRANSPORT LEGISLATION AMENDMENT BILL 2007

(Suggested amendments to be proposed in Committee by Ms HARTLAND)

That it be a suggestion to the Assembly that they make the following amendments in the Bill:

- 1. Clause 9, lines 10 and 11, omit "train drivers following fatal incidents" and insert "transport employees who witness or assist at serious or fatal incidents".
- 2. Clause 9, line 13, omit "train driver engaged by a train operator" and insert "transport employee".
- 3. Clause 9, line 16, omit "train driver" and insert "transport employee".
- 4. Clause 9, line 18, omit "train driver" and insert "transport employee".
- 5. Clause 9, lines 20 to 24, omit all words and expressions on these lines and insert—
 - "(a) the transport employee, acting in his or her capacity as a transport employee, was a witness to, or assisted at the scene of, a serious or fatal incident on a train or tram or involving a train or tram or on any property used by a passenger transport company in the provision of a passenger service; and".
- 6. Clause 9, line 29, after "driver" insert "or tram driver".
- 7. Clause 9, line 31, after "driver" insert "or tram driver".
- 8. Clause 9, page 15, line 10, omit "train driver" and insert "transport employee".
- 9. Clause 9, page 15, line 13, omit "train driver" and insert "transport employee".
- 10. Clause 9, page 15, line 16, omit "train driver" and insert "transport employee".
- 11. Clause 9, page 15, after line 24 insert—
 - "(7) In this section *transport employee* means a train driver or tram driver or other person engaged by a passenger transport company in the provision of a passenger service.".
- 12. Clause 23, omit this clause.

NEW CLAUSE

13. Insert the following New Clause to follow clause 22:

"A. New section 220DA inserted

After section 220D of the Transport Act 1983 insert—

"220DA Conditions relating to student concessions

The conditions determined under section 220D(1) must include a condition providing that all full-time students studying at educational institutions in Victoria are eligible for student concessions to use a public transport service.".
